CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

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- The Corporate Sponsoring Member is the CEO or senior executive participating in Rotary when his/her schedule permits but benefitting fully from affiliation with the prestigious downtown Rotary Club of Minneapolis (Club 9), the first Rotary club in Minnesota and 9th nationally (almost 35,000 clubs across the globe).

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP COSTS*

- Each member – Corporate Sponsoring Member and Active Member – will be billed separately.
- The Corporate Sponsoring Member pays a \$50 Initiation fee plus \$360 every six months or \$60/month. Lunches are not pre-paid. When this member attends, the cost of lunch is \$25.
- The Active Member pays a \$100 Initiation fee plus \$720 each six months or \$120 each month. Lunches are pre-paid.
